By Car

Car Parking is at Allestree Park main car park, accessed by a long driveway off Burley Hill (A6). (119/SK349407; Post Code DE22 2EU)

The event will be signed from the A6 in both directions. Take care turning off the A6, especially if travelling from the north, as traffic can be quite very fast along this road.

Car parking is expected to be tight, so please share transport if possible.

By Public Transport

The bus services which pass Allestree Park are the Trent Barton 'sixes' (6.1, 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4). These all pass by the main entrance to Allestree Park off Burley Hill (A6).
