Safety Note

All courses (with the exception of courses 5, 6 & 7) will go into Buxton town centre. There will be one timed road crossing (marshalled) into the old town then out to various parts of Buxton Competitors will face other road crossings during the event. Please negotiate with caution. The junior course has been planned to stay within the Gardens, Slopes, Serpentine plus a quiet housing estate, crossing a lightly used road with a mandatory marshalled crossing The young junior course is contained within the park. Under 16's will be allowed to run open courses if shadowed by an adult.

Competitors please bear in mind the well-being and safety of other town centre users. Respect other peoples' properties. Where there are impassable walls/fences/hedges, competitors will not try to cross them. Take care when crossing any roads.

For safety reasons the promenade will be out of bounds while competing. There is a brass band performance from 1pm, plus a Summer Fair
