**Terrain:** Mixed woodland with an intricate ride network, as shown on

**Car parking and Assembly:** The event will be signed from the A444 at Overseal. Parking will be on a field in the wood, accessed along a track adjacent to Grangewood public car park.

**Courses:** White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue, Brown  
(NB there is no string course despite the earlier flier)

**Entries and fees:** Entry on the day only.

**Adults** on Light Green, Green, Blue, Brown courses: £7 (members of British Orienteering); £9 (non-members)

**Adults** on White, Yellow, Orange courses: £3.50

**Children and Students:** £3.50 (the String course is free)

**Family** £17.50 (members of British Orienteering); £21.50 (non-members)

**Family** groups with a Child on White, Yellow or Orange will pay £3.50 for one map and can purchase additional maps for 50p

**Please include your British Orienteering membership number on your registration form.**

**Timing:** This event will feature SIAC touch free punching. All other SI dibbers will work as normal. If you do not have an SI dibber, you can hire one at Registration. Hire fee of 50p for Adults, free for Children & Students. You may also hire an SIAC dibber for £2 on a first come first served basis.

**Registration on the day only:** 10:00 until 12:00.

**Start Times:** From 10:30 to 12:30. The start is 400m from car park and finish is adjacent to car park.

**Courses close at 14:30.** Please report to Download even if you retire.

**Toilets:** in event car park field.

**Parking:** £2, please have this to hand before the car park field. The parking charge will be donated to The Brain Tumour Charity.

**Map:** 1:10000 for brown, 1:7500 for all other courses, 5m contour interval. Mapped by Richard Parkin, 2016.

**Dogs:** Dogs are not allowed on courses, they are permitted in car park field – please keep them on a lead and clean up after them.

**Safety:** The area is used for horse riding, please be aware of horses and walk past rather than running. Shorts are not permitted.

All competitors must report to download even if they retire. Courses close at 14:30 after which controls will be collected. You must still report to the finish and download even if you miss the cut-off time, to avoid a search being instigated.
