Darley Park

(Derby – 1.5 Miles from the Pentagon Island – A52 into Derby)
(Please note, this is not at the usual venue at Darley Abbey)

(Courses suitable for novices and experienced orienteers with help and advice available)

Terrain: Mainly flat parkland with steep woodland on the west side.

Entries and fees: Entry on the day only.

Adults £3.00

Children and Students: £1.50

Timing: The event will use Sportident electronic punching. If you do not have a Sportident card, you can hire one free at Registration.

Registration on the day only: 10.00 am until 11:30 am

Start Times: From 10.30 am to 12 noon. The start and finish are approximately 300 metres from the City Rd Car Park. They can be found by following the Footbridge over the River Derwent

Courses close at 13:30. You must report to Download even if you retire to avoid a needless search.

Toilets: There are no toilets near the vicinity of the Car Park, but toilets can be found at the Darley Park Sports Facilities (Old Chester Road, DE1 3SA GR SK353375) and at the North end of the Park close to the Park Cafe

Parking: Parking is free and is accessed from City Rd, DE1 3RR (Please note, you cannot access the Car Park from any other route apart from the Mansfield Road end. Mansfield Road is DE13QZ)

Map: Darley Park

Dogs: Dogs are warmly welcomed but we ask that owners keep a close control and that they should clean up any mess. Dogs are not allowed on the courses.

Safety: Competitors are to note that on the East side of the event area flows the River Derwent and can at times be dangerous. No courses will require competitors to access the bank but some controls maybe near the bank.
