



Level C Orienteering Event

11 December 2016

Eyam Moor

(Buxton 13 miles to the West, Chesterfield 13 miles to the East)

Terrain: Open Moorland, with limited paths but some good contour features.

Car parking and Assembly: Car Parking is to be found on the gravelled section of the Sir William Hill Road.

Nearest Post Code: S32 5QT

Lat: (WGS84) 53.29

Long: (WGS84) -1.66

Grid Reference: OL24 SK 224780 (Entrance to gravelled section of Sir William Hill Road)

Access: It is suggested that competitors access the event area from Grindleford. The event will be signposted from the junction of B6521 & B6001 SK 244777. The turning onto Sir William Hill Road is directly opposite the Sir William Hill Inn (B6001)

Courses: White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue & Brown

Entries and fees: Entry on the day only.

Adults: Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue and Brown £7.00 (Members of British Orienteering) £9.00 (Non-Members)

Adults: White, Yellow & Orange £3.50

Family: £17.50 (Members of British Orienteering) £19.50 (Non-members)

Family: Groups with a Child on White, Yellow or Orange will pay £3.50 for one map and can purchase additional maps for 50p

Students and Children: £3.50

Registration on the day only: 10.00 am until 12.00

Start Times: From 10.30 am to 12.30. The start and finish are adjacent to Registration and Download

Courses close at 14:00, after which controls will be collected. Anyone likely to take longer than 90 minutes should start well before 12.30 or compete in a short course. You must report to Finish and Download by 14:00 even if you retire to avoid a search.

Please include your British Orienteering membership number on the Registration Form

Timing: The event will use Sportident electronic punching. If you do not have a Sportident card, you can hire one, Adults 50p and free for Students and Children at Registration. All versions of SI dibbers will work but SIAC touch free punching also will be enabled. SIAC dibbers can be hired for £2.

Toilets: Portaloos will be situated in the Assembly Area.

Parking: No charge for Parking

Dogs: Dogs must be on a lead whilst in the Car Park and Assembly Area and are not allowed on the event area during the competition. Any poo must be removed.

Safety: Shorts are not permitted and full leg cover is required.

Whistles must be carried and a compulsory check will be made at the stile into the competition area.

We recommend that competitors carry a waterproof hooded jacket and, if it is very cold, a hat and gloves as well. The Organiser (on advice given by the Controller) may decide that waterproofs will be compulsory, in which case a notice will be posted on the DVO Website and/or on approaching the Car Park.
