#### **FINAL DETAILS**

Terrain: Mature mixed woodland on a large hill with many paths and areas of fast open forest.

**Car Parking:** Parking is in the public Calton Lees car park. (adjacent to the Garden Centre); pay £3 at the kiosk; you will then be directed down towards the far end of the car park after you have paid. Please do NOT park in the garden centre car park or on any nearby grass verges; we need to maintain our good relationship with the Chatsworth estate so we can continue to put events on at Lindop.

Registration/Assembly will be at the far end of the car park.

#### **Travel directions:**

From Chesterfield and Sheffield, follow the signs to Chatsworth House then continue through the park on the B6012, turn right towards Calton Lees, watch for the car park sign;

From Matlock and Bakewell follow the A6 to Rowsley, turn on the B6012 through Beeley then turn left at the Calton Lees car park sign. The event will be signed in both directions from the B6012 in to the Calton Lees car park.

Entries and fees: Entry on the day only.

Adults Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue and Brown courses: £7.00 (members of British Orienteering); £9.00 (non-members)

Adults White, Yellow and Orange courses: £3.50

Children and Students: £3.50

Family £17.50 (Members of British Orienteering); £19.50 (non-members)

**Family** Groups with a child on White, Yellow or Orange will pay £3.50 for one map and can purchase additional maps for 50p.

#### **Course Lengths:**

White 2.4k 65m climb Yellow 3.0k, 75m climb Orange 3.6k, 100m climb Light Green 4.1k, 120m climb Short Green 2.9k, 105m climb Green 3.9k, 110m climb Blue 6.0k, 215m climb Brown 7.4k, 230m climb

There will not be a String Course at this event.

Registration on the day only: 10.00 until 12.00.

**Start Times:** From 10.30 to 12:30. Roughly 20 minute gradual uphill walk to the start along a private road and then track/path, and back from the finish in reverse.,

Courses close at 14:00, after which controls will be collected. Anyone likely to take longer than 90 minutes should start well before 12.30 or compete on a short course. You must report to Finish and Download by 14:00 even if you retire to avoid a search.

Please report to **Download** even if you retire.

Please include your British Orienteering membership number on your registration form.

**Timing:** The event will use Sportident electronic punching. If you do not have a Sportident card, you can hire one at Registration. Hire fee of 50p for Adults, free for Children & Students. All versions of SI Dibbers will work but SIAC touch free punching also will be enabled. SIAC Dibbers can be hired for £2.00

**Toilets**: The garden centre have kindly agreed we can use their toilets, situated OUTSIDE the garden centre, roughly 2-3 minutes walk from the Calton Lees car park, they will be signed. Please take muddy shoes off to try and keep the floors as clean as possible. Visitors to the garden centre will also be using these toilets.

Dogs: Dogs must be on a lead whilst in the car park and assembly area and are not allowed in the event area.

**Safety:** Shorts are not permitted and full leg cover is required Whistles are recommended. The Organiser (on advice from the Controller) may decide that waterproofs are compulsory, in which case a notice will be posted on the DVO website and at Registration.
