



Hall Leys Park, Matlock

Part of the Matlock Summer Series

Courses suitable for novices and experienced orienteers with help and advice available

Hall Leys is an ornamental park with a play area and boating lake, right in the centre of Matlock. Post code DE4 3AR.



Parking: Limited parking on Causeway Lane/A615. The closest car park is the pay & display at Imperial Road (between the Town Hall and Wilkos). Exit the crown mini-roundabout on Bank Road and take the first left onto Imperial Road. The car park is on the left.

Fees: £4 adults, £2 juniors and students.
Entry on the day only.

Timing: The event will use SportIdent electronic punching (dibbers). If you don't have an SI card, you can borrow one for free at Registration.

Registration: Registration and Starts 6:30–7pm at the bandstand. Courses close at 8pm and use the following areas:

Short (Yellow): Hall Leys Park, 1:2000 scale

Medium (Orange): Hall Leys, Pic Tor and Old Matlock, 1:3500 scale

Long (Light Green): Matlock Urban map, 1:5000 (**under 16s not allowed on this course**)

Safety: Courses close at 8pm, after which controls will be collected. You must report to Download even if you retire, to avoid a needless search. A risk assessment has been carried out by the Organiser and the Planner. However, participants do take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event.

Toilets: Please note the toilets in the Park are locked after 6pm. The nearest ones are in M&S or Sainsbury's.

Dogs: Dogs are not allowed on the orienteering courses.
