



## Informal Orienteering Event

### **Shipley Country Park**

(main entrance 1km south of Heanor centre)

(Courses suitable for novices and experienced orienteers with help and advice available)

**Terrain:** Typical Country Park: lots of open areas with many paths, some wooded areas. ( Good adventure playground. )

**Car parking and Assembly:** Follow Brown sign from A 608 between Heanor and Derby ( just 300m from Tesco's Roundabout.), then follow straight road.

**Nearest Post Code:** DE75 7GX

Grid Reference: 431452

**Courses:** : Short ( White/Yellow), Medium ( Orange) and Long (Light Green)

**Entries and fees:** Entry on the day only.

**Adults** £5.00

**Children and Students:** £3.00

**Timing:** The event will use Sportident electronic punching. If you do not have a Sportident card, you can borrow one free at Registration.

**Registration on the day only:** 12.30pm - 2.00pm in the Visitors' Centre

**Start Times:** From 1 pm to 2.45pm. The start and finish are next to the Visitor Centre

**Courses close at 3:30pm. You must report to Download even if you retire, to avoid a needless search.**

**Toilets:** in the Visitors' Centre

**Parking:** Pay at machine. £1.60 for 2hrs, £3.00 for 4 hrs. Correct change, or card.

**Map:** Andy Hawkins 2011, 1:10,000, 5m contours, updated 2017

**Dogs:** Dogs are not allowed on courses, they are permitted in car park/assembly but must be on a lead and any poo removed

**Safety:** Roads with park traffic on Medium and Long. Shorts are not permitted.
