Area

Staunton Harold Reservoir, Melbourne, Derbyshire
Follow the 'brown signs' to the Severn Trent car park on the B587 to the south of Melbourne.
Post code for SatNav: DE73 8DL; Grid Reference: SK 377 244

Car park location

Car parking is in the Severn Trent car park immediately adjacent to the café and toilets.

Public transport

There are regular buses through Melbourne from Derby and Burton
Alight in Melbourne then 1 mile walk to the park

Car park fee: £2.50 all day

Registration times

12.00 - 15.00. Registration will be at the southern edge of the car park. The start and the finish are adjacent to the car park.

12.00 - 15.00

Courses

Short, medium and long. Courses range from 1.5 to 3.5km. Control descriptions will be printed on the map. Loose descriptions will be available from registration. All courses close at 4.00pm

Please note that competitors must report to download even if retiring

Terrain description

*A new area for orienteering. Mixed parkland with a small area of mature woodland and some areas of scattered trees. Some undergrowth in places but an extensive path network. **Full leg cover is required** and competitors are advised to carry whistles. There is a quiet minor road through the area (the access road to the car park and yacht club) that all courses will cross.*

Maps

1:5,000 with 5m contours; surveyed and drawn in 2015/16 by Mike Godfree

Safety

Competitors take part at their own risk. Whistles are advised. Once you have started a course you must report to Download, even if you retire

Dogs

Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a lead at all times.

Facilities

All adjacent to the Car Park. Toilets, café, and play area for the kids!
