Score and Maze in the Park courses suitable for novices and experienced orienteers with help and advice available

Terrain: The Whitworth Park is an immaculately kept Victorian town park; with a network of paved footpaths around the ponds, flowerbeds, skateboard park and semi-rough grassed areas.

Car parking and Assembly: Abundant free parking in the car park accessed from the A6. Assembly/ Registration is at the front of the Hall on the terrace, over looking the park. **Nearest Post Code: DE4 2EQ**

Entries fees: Adults £4.00 Children and Students: £2

Timing: The event will use Sportident electronic punching.

If you do not have a Sportident card - children can hire one free and adults £1.

Start Times: From 5pm to 7:30pm. The start and finish are at the front of the Hall.

Courses close at 8pm and controls collected.

Toilets: available in the Hall/ visitors centre

Dogs: well behaved dogs on leads welcomed in the park.

Safety: This is a public park used by many other people and there are deep ponds. Long trousers (full leg cover) are required as some parts have nettles and brambles.
