



DVO Club Handicap Championships and Annual Awards Saturday 25th November 2017

Ilam Park, Dovedale

Start times approx 10:30 - 11:30 depending on handicap. Your start time is set with the intention that everyone will finish together. So everyone has a chance of winning. Start times will be published on DVO web site. Call up will be at -90 seconds, loose control descriptions and blank maps in the start lanes. Punching start in order to simplify calculations.

Courses. Long and Medium courses have a map exchange, remember to punch the changeover control.

Junior course will have a "smiley face" at one point.

Short	3.0Km + 35m climb	15 controls
Medium	5.6Km + 95m	27 controls
Long	6.9Km + 115m	30 controls
Junior	1.9Km + 30m	14 controls

Map 1:5000 with 5m. contours, with enlargement to 1:2500 around the Hall. Updated autumn 2017.

Lithuanian trophy to first unaccompanied junior to finish on the Junior course. Trophies will be awarded at the lunch around 13:00 together with the club's annual awards.

Start and finish immediately in front of the Hall. Hire dibber collection etc in school room.
