Family (yellow standard) - visit as many controls as you can within 40 minutes and senior (orange/light green standard) courses.

SI Electronic Punching - you can hire a timing chip at registration free. There is a charge if not returned.

Charges £4.00 adults, £2.00 juniors (up to age 20), families £6.00

Courses: Family course – 3Km, all on paths, ideal for those with no experience. Senior course – 4.4Km, controls away from paths so demanding some navigation.

Entries and fees: Adults £4.00, Juniors £2.00. Family group £6.00

Timing: The event will use Sportident electronic punching. If you do not have a Sportident card, you can hire one free at Registration. There would be a charge for any SI cards not returned.

Start Times: 11:00 am until 14:30.

Courses close at 16:00. You must report to Download even if you retire to avoid a needless search.

Toilets: At Visitor Centre .

Dogs: Dogs are not allowed on courses.
