



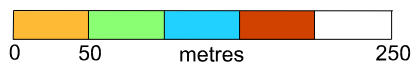

Course Notes

Covid safety - Before running this course please make yourself aware of, and abide by, the British Orienteering Code of Conduct for orienteering in a Covid-safe way.

There are 2 major, very busy roads that must be crossed on the courses. The King Street/Duffield Road which bisect the map N/S and Kedleston Road which runs diagonally SE to NW. The area around '5 Lamps' is always very busy and a crossing point with a central control has been added to the map to highlight this. Please be very, very careful in this area.

The map is formed from the eastern section of the Urban Map of Derby West, the north and western section of Darley Park and a new area in the south east extending towards St Mary's Bridge and bordered on the south by the Derby Central Ring Road.

The Middle Course is 5.2km with 65 m climb with an optimal route distance of approx. 6.3km.

The Long Course is 7.1km with 90m of climb and an optimal route distance of approx. 9.1km.

All sites have been checked but, depending on direction of approach some controls may be affected by high buildings or leaf canopies. If you are sure that you are in the right place but do not get a signal move on as your track will indicate your proximity to the control site.

Parking

There is a FREE small car park close to the start and is shown on the map. It fills up quickly at various times during the day but the changeover rate is high. It can only be approached from the Broadway Island down Darley Park Drive. If the car park is full there is ample street parking to the north on Darley park Road, Windley Crescent and Vicarwood Avenue.

Toilets

These are open near the Darley Abbey Tea Rooms. From the car park they are about 200m from the gates into the park following the path to the left.
