

Derwent Neighbourhood Maprun

The map overleaf shows the positions of a number of check points spread around the Derwent neighbourhood. There are no markers at them, instead the Maprunf app in a smartphone will confirm when you are at each of them. The aim is to visit all of them in the least time, so order and route choice are key. First you need to install the free Maprunf (not the older Maprun) app from either Google Play for Android phones or the App Store for iPhones. Once installed make sure you allow the app access to Location Services or GPS. Within the app whilst you have a wifi connection go to Select Event, choose UK/Derbyshire/Derwent Valley/Derwent/Derwent run. That will download a phone map and a course. When you are ready to run press Go to Start and your current position will show as a red dot on the map. Go to any of the control points and when you are close your phone will ping and your timing has started. Visit as many of the other check points as you can, when you return to the one you started with timing will finish. If you wish your results will upload and you can compare your results with other runners.

There is a host of information on the Derwent Valley Orienteers website www.dvo.org.uk, look for the menu item Maprun Courses.

On orienteering maps open areas like parks are shown in yellow, busier roads are shown in brown with solid black edges, minor roads are shown as black lines, footpaths are shown as black dashed lines. Gardens and other private areas are shown in olive green, do not attempt to enter these. Major buildings are shown in grey with a black outline.

There are a variety of other Maprun courses around Derby and further afield. They vary from city parks like Darley Parks and Markeaton to urban areas like Mickleover, Sinfin and Chellaston. Many of them are linear courses of different lengths where you visit the controls points in the correct order. Once the pandemic is over the club will resume competitive events throughout Derbyshire.
