

Virtually Derby West ... is an orienteering test using the Derwent Valley Orienteers Urban Map of Derby West and Google Maps/Street View.

The object of the exercise is to work around the course and using your combined orienteering skills and ability to delve into the Street View technology in order to identify the features of each of the control sites. Control descriptions take the form of a 'clue sheet'.

A note to help you- Street View can be wound forward and backwards in time ... just check which date you are on as you 'run' round.
