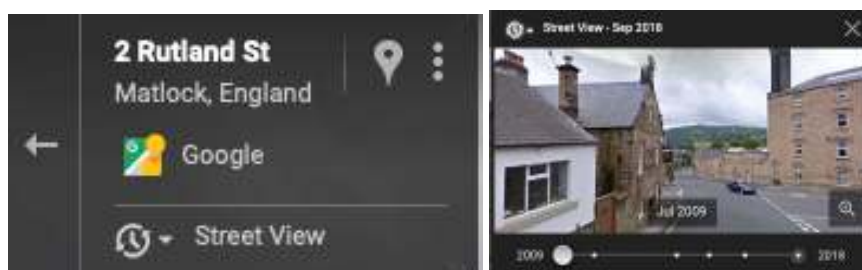


Virtually Matlock ... is an orienteering test using the Derwent Valley Orienteers Urban Map of Matlock and Google Maps/Street View.

The object of the exercise is to work around the course and using your combined orienteering skills and ability to delve into the Street View technology in order to identify the features of each of the control sites. Control descriptions take the form of a 'clue sheet'.

A note to help you- Street View can be wound forward and backwards in time ... just check which date you are on as you 'run' round.



To check which version you are viewing look down at the bottom right of your screen for the image capture date: **Image capture: Aug 2009**

If you don't want to cheat and wish to be competitive then prepare by printing off the Urban map of Matlock (no looking yet) and printing off the control description/clue sheet. Open up Google Maps on a device of your choice and navigate (pun intended) to the map of Matlock. Get your stopwatch/timing device ready.

Place the Urban Map face down on a table (or something) and then say 'Beep, Beep, Beep, **Beep**'. On the last '**Beep**' start your timer, pick up the map, find the start triangle and you are away.
